COURSE Outline:

Session #1 (June 11, 2022): Play and imagination in work with children: The Transitional Space
Here the focus will be on working with the child either individually or in groups. Case material will be presented.

Session #2 (June 25, 2022): Reaching adolescents through expressive arts: Tearing down and rebuilding
Typically, teens are difficult to reach. We will look at how the expressive arts can help to engage this population.

Session #3 (July 2, 2022): Working with systems: the child, the family and the outside world
In working with children and adolescents, consideration always must be given to the contexts in which they live. We will look at the various ways in which therapists need to involve themselves with these larger systems.

Session #4 (July 16, 2022): Case Studies and supervision sessions
Case material will be presented and participants will be invited to present issues and questions from their own work for discussion with the presenter and with other participants.
