

The following is a list of practicum sites for 2011-2012:

#### HINCKS-DELLCREST CENTRE

- Out-Patient--group and individual work with children and parents, In-Patient--groups for residential teens , Residential Summer Camp, Farm Programme

#### HUMEWOOD HOUSE

- a residential, school treatment program and counseling centre for young women who are dealing with pregnancy and parenthood

#### PARENT/CHILD MOTHER GOOSE PROGRAM

- story telling, movement and voice to build and support the relationship between parent and child

#### MUKI BAUM CENTRE--ADULT and CHILDREN'S DIVISION

- group and individual work using all the arts (theatre, visual art, music, dance, poetry) to support dually diagnosed adults and children

#### BAYCREST JEWISH HOME for the AGED

- adults who have psychiatric and geriatric issues in a long-term care facility

#### TORONTO GENERAL HOSPITAL/EATING DISORDER UNIT

- expressive arts therapy group with clients who have eating disorders.

#### YWCA ARISE/ WOMEN'S SHELTER

- individual and group expressive arts therapy with women and children who have been exposed to family violence.

#### BLOORVIEW KIDS REHAB – SPIRAL GARDEN

- an arts based children's summer camp program for children with a variety of physical, emotional and developmental challenges.

#### ALLIANCE HOSPICE

- home visits with clients, doing one on one and/or group expressive arts therapy

#### PERRAM HOUSE

- expressive arts therapy with adults living with a life altering illness. These adults have experienced homelessness or have marginalized housing.

HOLY BLOSSOM TEMPLE

- community expressive arts - movement, voice; poetry, visual art and humour - with adults over 70

TERRI SEGAL'S DRUMMING WORKSHOPS

- drumming workshops in a variety of social service agencies with the elderly, adults, youth and children throughout Toronto

BRIDGEPOINT HOSPITAL

- one on one expressive arts therapy with adults living with a variety of physical and emotional issues

MARGARET FRAZER

- an expressive arts therapy group with women who have mental health problems.

JUMBLIES THEATRE

- community arts using intermodal theatre group work

DOROTHY LEY HOSPICE

- community arts-based day program with adults and children living with a life changing illness.

CREATIVE WORKS STUDIO

- community open art studio in a visual arts program for adults with mental health problems living in the community

SOJOURN HOUSE

- expressive arts therapy groups with refugee children and adults staying in transitional housing for up to two years.

ONTARIO CORRECTIONS

- expressive arts group with adult men who are in corrections.

COVENANT HOUSE

- a mixed media art group in a drop-in open studio with youth

WOMENS HABITAT

- expressive arts group with women who live with mental health problems, have issues with addictions and have left abusive relationships.

HOUSE OF COMPASSION

- an expressive arts therapy group with adults with mental health issues

THE MILKWEED COLLECTIVE

- Exploring Creativity in Depth for elementary school classes, grades 1 to 8.

TORONTO HOSPICE

- expressive arts therapy in a group setting, with adults who have a life altering illness.

GILDA'S CLUB TORONTO

- variety of arts based groups for children, youth and adults, whom have been touched by cancer.

ACCESS ALLIANCE MULTICULTURAL COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTRE

- expressive arts groups with refugee, immigrant and newcomer women.

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
